NAMEN promotes accountability within the Region



On September 11th - 15th NAMEN traveled to Istanbul Turkey as the representative for the region to actively participate in the Accountability Framework training sponsored by the MenEngage Alliance.

In this impactful learning series, NAMEN's Interim Executive Director Coach Lynn, joined dedicated representatives from around the world, pooling their expertise, talents and experiences towards the comprehensive development of an accountability framework outreach initiative to be deployed throughout the regions.

In this and as specified in the Accountability Framework doctrine, three core documents are designated as pillars to the MenEngage Alliance work:

- A) Our Core Principles setting the values, principles and commitments shared by members.
- B) Our Code of Conduct outlining the behaviors and practices we commit to upholding as individuals working for gender justice.
- C) Out Accountability Standards relating to institutional commitments and aspirations for how we do our work. {Accountability Framework 2023}

In furtherance of this critical work, NAMEN as part of the strategic planning committee is working on key elements of the initiative with plans of rolling out the final version in 2025 yet with intermittent regional training beginning in 2024.





Letter from MenEngage - Call For An Immediate Ceasefire In The Palestine-Israel Conflict

We are heartbroken by the violence, devastation, and loss of life in Gaza and Israel. We express our solidarity with those affected—directly or indirectly—by the conflict. We unite our voices with all who are calling on humanity to break the perpetual grip of war and violence around the world.

We stand with the voices of feminists—including in Palestine and Israel—in calling for an immediate ceasefire, for the return of hostages by Hamas, for urgent humanitarian aid to the people of Gaza, and for long term reparations towards sustainable peace and an end to intergenerational cycles of violence.

We must work together to create a more just and equitable world for all, where everyone can live free from trauma and violence.
